I am currently a Senior Scientist at the Human Nutrition Laboratory of ETH Zürich in Switzerland, and Extraordinary Associate Professor at the Centre of Excellence for Nutrition of the North-West University in South Africa. I hold an MSc in Food Science and Nutrition from ETH Zürich, Switzerland, where I also obtained my PhD in Human Nutrition. When South Africa won the bid to host the 2016 ISSFAL congress in Stellenbosch, I served on the organizing and scientific committee, and as such played a key role in the development of the scientific programme and organization of congress events, i.e. the Young Investigator Social.

Firstly, as a young, emerging scientist, I wish to ensure that the needs of students and early-career scientists are met, and will support their active participation at ISSFAL congresses and events.
